DETAILS OF OFFENSE PROGRESS OF INVESTIGATION, ETC.

SIRS: 9-3-73

On 8-8-73, at approximately 5:30PM, at the request of Lt. Porter of Homicide Division, I went to 4500 Silverbell to make an examination for latent prints. I dusted the area and obtained one (1) ~~xxx~~ latent print from a set of handlebars from a bicycle found inside the premises. Listed below are ~~xxx~~ items obtained from this location and submitted to the Latent Laboratory for further examination.

- (3) shovels and one broken handle rake
- (2) plastic bags, one containing assorted clothes
- (3) paper bags of lime, two (2) full, one (1) empty, Red Top brand
- (1) high rise handlebar from a ~~xxx~~ bicycle
- (10) empty soda water bottles
- (2) brown paper bags
- (1) envelope, containing pornographic literature
- (1) set of license plates #1972 Texas ADK-309

Examination of this evidence revealed one latent print on the handlebar and one latent print on one of the shovels. The assorted clothes were submitted to Chemist J. Zotter of the Crime Lab on 8-9-73.

On 8-14-73 Chemist J. Zotter of the Crime Lab. submitted one (1) jar vaseline, one (1) paper sack and three (3) plastic gloves to the Latent Lab to be examined for latent prints. Examination of this evidence revealed no latent prints.

On 8-15-73 ~~xxxx~~ Detective SGT. D.M. Millican of the Pasadena P.D. Pasadena, Texas submitted the below listed items to the Latent Laboratory to be examined for latent prints.

- (1) tool box, color gray, containing
 - (1) artificial penis 17" long
 - (1) white tube
 - (2) glass ~~xxx~~ rods
 - (2) marijuana cigarettes

Examination of this evidence revealed no latent prints of value. This evidence was submitted to the Crime Lab. on 8-15-73, for further examination.

The latents obtained from the above evidence were retained in the latent Laboratory, with photographed latents from the shovel for a further comparison. The above described evidence was tagged in the property room under # 73260 on 9-3-73.
